Arrival/Drop off

Students will need to be dropped off at Christian Assembly (door C) by 6:30pm on Wednesday, June 12th, with all their stuff. (Christian Assembly is located at 4099 Karl Road, Columbus 43224. ***You as their parent will need to come in for the sign-in process to make sure your student's entire camp balance is paid and any forms needed are filled out unless you are coming with your youth pastor.***

Pick Up

Students will need picked up at Christian Assembly at 12:30 on Sunday, June 15th.

Meals

All meals are included in the cost. We will eat breakfast before we go out for the day. Sack lunches will be provided for lunch. Dinner will be served in the evening once everyone is back from the afternoon outreach. If you have any new or specific dietary concerns please let us know at check-in.

Outreach Opportunities:

We are asking that you consider bringing some items to help people on our trip:

1. **A gift bag for women working on the streets.** We will be partnering with the Salvation Army to help supply them with gift bags in the ministry they are doing to reach women stuck in prostitution and human trafficking. Here is a list of what to bring:
 - Dry foods/ ramen
 - Tampons
 - Snacks
 - Water
 - Hand sanitizer
 - Toilet paper
 - Clorox wipes
 - Pads
 - Chapstick
 - Toothbrush
 - Deodorant

2. **Candy or Small prizes for kids for the block parties** (this could include newly used toys laying around the house)

Serve the City Packing List:

- Bible
- Pen or pencil
- Notebook or journal
- Sunscreen
- Bathing Suit (one piece modest suit for girls and guys)
- Sunglasses
- Towel/s
- Long pants
- Casual clothing for outreach (tshirts etc) nothing you are worried about getting messy in.
- Work gloves
- Tennis shoes (or other hard sole closed toed shoes)
- Hat or cap,
- Camera
- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Deodorant!
- Spending money (if you want to for outreaches, just in case- but you probably won't need it),
- Any necessary prescribed medication
- Personal hygiene products
- Air mattress (optional)
- Pillow and sleeping bag (we will be sleeping on the floor at the church!!)
- Any special gifts you would like that could bless the people/kids we will serve.
